

## 15th Annual Art at the Crossroads General Information

We would like to invite you to show your artwork at the 15th Annual Art at the Crossroads regional art exhibit sponsored by Ash Grove Cement. Artwork will be accepted Tuesday, September 3rd, and the show will open on Friday, September 6, 2013. Cash awards totaling \$1000 will be awarded at the judge's discretion. A People's Choice cash award will be selected by those attending the opening reception.

### ENTRY CRITERIA

Art at the Crossroads is open to professional and amateur artists aged 18 and older. Each artist may submit a total of (3) three pieces completed in the past (2) two years and not previously shown at an Art at the Crossroads regional exhibit.

**The entry fee is \$15 for up to (3) works of art. Artists are encouraged to have their work for sale. There is a 30% commission for Crossroads members and 40% commission for non-members.**

All work must be original. All paintings must be dry and appropriately presented, mounted or framed, ready to hang with screw eyes and wire attached. No saw tooth hangers will be accepted. Reproductions, works made from kits or under the supervision of an instructor are not eligible.

The Gallery committee reserves the right to refuse any artwork which is inconsistent with the general quality of the exhibit. If there are more entries than space allows, it may be necessary to limit the number of works per artist shown. All reasonable care will be taken when handling artwork received.

### JUDGE: SUE LATTA

Sue Latta is a mixed media sculptor. She works with a vast range of materials including resins, metals (cast and fabricated), wood, glass, photographs, paper and found objects creating sculptural forms that are thoughtful as well as beautiful.

Sue has been a working artist for over 15 years. She received her MFA in sculpture in 2007 from Boise State University. She has done a number of public projects and received grants from the Idaho Commission on the Arts and the Boise City Arts Commission. Her work has been collected throughout the United States and Canada, and is included in the Permanent Collection at the University of Nevada Reno, Boise State University, the Boise Visual Chronicle and the Idaho Shakespeare Festival and in numerous private collections.

Sue has served as a LiveStrong Artist in Residence at the Saint Alphonsus Cancer Care Center and is currently an adjunct professor of art at Boise State University. She also owns The Sculpture Studio, a private teaching studio where she teaches a variety of 3-dimensional disciplines.
