Crossroads Carnegie Art Center is pleased announce that we are the recipient of a National Endowment for the Arts Challenge America Grant. We are the only Challenge America grantee in Oregon.

These funds, when we get our match in place, will allow us to do a feasibility study on the 1935 Welch Building across the street from the Carnegie Library Building (many of you will know it as the old KBKR Building.)

To receive a NEA Grant is a really big deal for an organization of our size. It's a door that once you get your foot in—the next time is so much easier.

We are also thrilled to receive the news that we received our 2015 Leo Adler Grant which will help promote our slate of remarkable 2015 gallery shows.

Farewell 2014 and Welcome to 2015...

As the Holiday rush is upon us it is the time for reflection on a busy year at Crossroads and a look forward to future projects.

Highlights of 2014 include Crossroads moving to monthly newsletters which allows us to better communicate programs and classes to our members. We have done significant work with our Legacy Giving Program and you should see policies and new literature out shortly. We have started having conversations with all our members about how they can leave gifts to Crossroads in their will and estates no matter how large or small.

We welcomed many special events and programs to Crossroads in 2014. We were thrilled to have Milagro Theatre from Portland—one of only six Latino Theater companies in the nation--come for a three day outreach working with a huge cross section of the community about the issues around immigration. We had a memorable community potluck where stories were told and barriers were broken down. They brought Frank Janzen, Tamarind Master Printer from Crow's Shadow Institute for a class as part of the workshop, and the grand finale was a powerful performance of Cunetanme Coyote written by Danal Malan of Milagro Theatre. In August we had one of our best and biggest productions of Missoula Children's Theatre and the kids worked so hard they raised enough money to bring MCT back TWICE in 2015—check out the class schedule and sign up TODAY!

We started new seasonal membership enrichment programs to add additional value to your membership and the response was terrific. The summer ice cream social with the Baker Community Orchestra in July and the Tribal Fusion Belly Dancing Performance in November were both well attended and raised needed dollars for the scholarship fund. We are looking for new ideas for programs, so please let us know if you have something you would like us to consider. We also started a new Summer Pledge Drive to raise additional funds at a critical time for Crossroads and you will see it again next year. This year with the support of the Juan Young Trust we had two Spring Break Saturday Kid Craft Days to do one last celebration of Crossroads 50th Anniversary year.

Before Gala we got the best present of the year, Elizabeth Mae Burks born to Board member Gypsy Burks and her husband Matt. I have a baby to spoil!

Gala was a huge success with year and we so appreciate all your support of the art center. We are having one of our best Christmas Shows ever and look forward to an amazing 2015.

I Survived Make It and Take It!

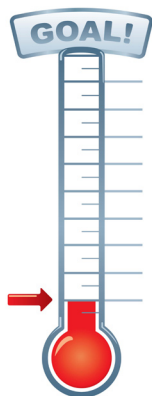
