SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The April Open Regional Show is open to professional and amateur artists aged 18 years and older.
- If artists are unable to attend the Night at the Baker Heritage Museum on January 9, 2015, they may call ahead and make an appointment with the Museum to see the exhibits and collections on Thursday and Fridays from 10 am to 3 pm.
- The Museum would like to exhibit the artwork from the April show at the Museum in June/July 2015. We will ask each artist participating for permission to show their artwork at each venue.
- Artists may take photographs of the exhibits, but please be sure to confirm with the staff or volunteers of the Museum before doing so.
- There is a \$10 entry fee for up to three pieces of art. We encourage new work created specifically for the show and a brief statement regarding your interpretation of the theme.
- A “People’s Choice” Award of \$150 will be selected during the Opening Reception.
- All work must be original. All paintings must be dry, and ready to hang with screw eyes and wire attached. Saw-tooth hangers will not be accepted. If artwork has special hanging requirements, please contact gallery.
- Reproductions, works made form kits or under the supervision of an instructor are not eligible.
- If artwork is over 50 lbs. or over 40” x 40”, please make arrangements with the gallery prior to March 14, 2015. Hanging and size restrictions may apply.
- It is preferable that the work be for sale. There is a 30% commission for Crossroads members and a 40% commission for non-members.
- We are unable to accept late entries.
