We would like to invite you as local and regional fine artists, designers and craft persons to show your artwork at our annual December open show *A Holiday Gathering*. We are looking for fine art, small prints, fine crafts, mixed media, sculpture, high quality local hand-crafted gifts and original tree ornaments.\* We find that items in the \$15 to \$75 range sell best.

*\*Ornament contest – Join us for an ornament contest in conjunction with “A Holiday Gathering” open show. During the opening reception, November 23rd, the public will vote for their favorite ornament in each category and a small prize will be awarded to the artist.*

**Catagories:** Traditional, cat’s preference, kitsch, and artist’s choice (other).

### ENTRY CRITERIA

A Holiday Gathering is open to professional and amateur artists aged 18 and older. All work must be original. Paintings must be dry and appropriately presented, mounted or framed, ready to hang with screw eyes and wire attached. No saw tooth hangers will be accepted. Prints should be appropriately covered to protect artwork. If this is your first time entering a Crossroads open show and you have questions regarding your work, please call the gallery for clarification at 541-523-5369.

Work submitted must be of original design and of high quality. Work that is manufactured, imported, reproduction made from kits or under the supervision of an instructor is not eligible. The gallery committee reserves the right to refuse any artwork which is inconsistent with the general quality of the exhibit.

We are able to accept a larger number of smaller pieces for the December show. If there are more entries than space allows, it may be necessary to limit the number of works per artist shown. All reasonable care will be taken when handling artwork received.

There is no entry fee for this show and all items must be available for sale. There is a 30% commission for Crossroads member artists and a 40% commission for non-members. It is the artist’s responsibility to check inventory throughout the month and replenish work as space becomes available.
